## **Alcohol Testing**

Alcohol testing information: Breath alcohol testing detects alcohol in the body for up to approximately 8 hours depending on how much alcohol is consumed. Breath alcohol tests should be administered as soon as possible because alcohol leaves the breath at a rapid rate. Please arrange a ride for anyone who may be under the influence of alcohol and do not let them drive.

EtG/EtS tests are administered to clients who should abstain from alcohol completely because alcohol is a legal substance. There is no way to determine EXACTLY how much or when alcohol was consumed based on the results of an EtG/EtS test
